 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ERNEST WOODCOCK  
 SELMA, OR 97538

confirms the right to use the waters of CEDAR CREEK, a tributary to ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION 10.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-11696. The date of priority is JUNE 6, 1935. The amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for such purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1<sup>st</sup> to November 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 12349, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 6 2013, approving Transfer Application T-11369. This certificate also describes those lands authorized in the diminution to supplemental irrigation under the same order approving Transfer Application T-11369.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition will be deemed denied.
