CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, tributary to ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 20.6 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is MAY 1887.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR EACH 50 ACRES OF LAND IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON OF APRIL 1 THROUGH NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR (0.41 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

39 S	8 W	WM	27	SE NW	KERBY DITCH - 990 FEET NORTH AND 840 FEET WEST FROM C1/4 CORNER, SECTION 27

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 3, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 1, approving Transfer Application 8521, and supercedes that portion of Certificate 42163 as modified by Transfer Application T-4173, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
