CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, tributary to ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 12.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-44911. The date of priority is MARCH 15, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

39 S	8 W	WM	16	NE NW	940 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 16

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

39 S	8 W	WM	27	SE NW	KERBY DITCH - 990 FEET NORTH AND 840 FEET WEST FROM C1/4 CORNER, SECTION 27

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 3, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 1, approving Transfer Application 8521, and confirms the appropriation under Permit S-44911.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
