CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Robert and Joanne Torres
47341 Steele Hill Rd.,
Halfway, OR 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of Pine Creek, a tributary of the Snake River, for Irrigation of 38.0 acres, domestic and stock use.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Engineer in Volume 11, at page 235. The date of priority is 1886.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually used beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of a cubic foot per second per acre, measured at the point of diversion and a total limitation of one acre-foot per acre during July, one acre-foot per acre during August and one-half acre-foot per acre during September, of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 13, 1999 recorded in Special Order Volume 53, Pages 1047 - 1049, approving Transfer Application T-7811 and supersedes Certificate 10406, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
