confirms the right to use the waters of SPRINGS IN SECTION 28, T 38 S, R 8 W, W.M., tributaries to HENDERSON CREEK for RESERVOIR MAINTENANCE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is 1903.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.132 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion (springs) are located as follows:

38 S	8 W	WM	28	SW NE	SOUTH SPRING - 150 FEET SOUTH & 450 FEET WEST FROM NE 1/16 CORNER, SECTION 28

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
38 S	8 W	WM	27	SW NW

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 12, 2005, at Special Order Volume 67, Page 28, approving Transfer Application 9491, and together with Certificate 81651, supersedes Certificate 13879, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
