CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

QUIET VALLEY FARMS PO BOX 295 LANGLOIS OR 97450

confirms the right to use the waters of DAVIS CREEK, tributary to CROFT LAKE for CRANBERRY USE (HARVESTING AND IRRIGATION) of 10.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-20725. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 10, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND THE TOTAL ANNUAL VOLUME OF WATER SHALL BE LIMITED TO 50.0 ACRE-FEET DIVERTED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON OF EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre; For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cubic foot per second per acre; For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of the each year. For the irrigation of any other crop, ONE EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 13, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 617, approving Transfer Application 10309, and together with Certificate 86080, supersedes Certificate 45739, State record of Water Right Certificates.
