CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LESLIE M. HENDERSON

confirms the right to use the waters of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, tributary to SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.50 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1883.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre (0.013 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 29, 2006, at Special Order Volume 69, Page 1087, approving Transfer Application 10034, and together with Certificate 82334, supersedes Certificate 6247, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
