CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EMOGENE HIERSCHE 7700 NE PARKWAY DR #300 VANCOUVER WA 98662

confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK, tributary to UMATILLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 4.32 ACRES AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127. The dates of priority are 1892 AND 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.055 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.015 CFS FOR PRIORITY DATE 1892 AND 0.040 CFS FOR PRIORITY DATE 1906, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, and subject to the provisions and limitations of paragraph 33 of the Umatilla River Decree.

The points of diversion (two hydraulically connected sumps) are located as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 11, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 195, approving Transfer Application 6718, and together with Certificate 79947, supercedes Certificate 2549, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
