CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC CO. 121 SW SALMON ST PORTLAND OR 97204

confirms the right to use the waters of the DESCHUTES RIVER, TRIBUTARY TO THE COLUMBIA RIVER for DOMESTIC EXPANDED FOR 7 HOUSEHOLDS, IRRIGATION OF UP TO ½ ACRE LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDENS FOR 9 HOUSEHOLDS, AND IRRIGATION 1.66 ACRES.

This right was perfected under permit S-50237. The date of priority is OCTOBER 29, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.03 CFS FOR DOMESTIC EXPANDED FOR 7 HOUSEHOLDS; 0.11 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF UP TO ½ ACRE LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDENS FOR 9 HOUSEHOLDS; AND 0.04 CFS FOR IRRIGATION of 1.66 ACRES or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion (a well).

The point of diversion (a well) is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion located as follows:
