 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC CO.
 121 SW SALMON ST
 PORTLAND OR 97204

confirms the right to use the waters of the DESCHUTES RIVER, TRIBUTARY TO THE COLUMBIA RIVER for DOMESTIC USE FOR 9 FAMILIES.

This right was perfected under permit S-25800. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 25, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion (A well) is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion located as follows:

The use of water under this right shall be subject to regulation consistent with other water rights from the surface water source and to all other applicable conditions and restrictions that existed at the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change FROM A SURFACE WATER DIVERSION TO A GROUNDWATER POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 15, 2011, at Special Order Volume 84, Page 758, approving Transfer Application T-8307, and supersedes Certificate 27497, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
