CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

APPLEGATE INVESTMENTS INC.
 HUNTER, BILLY JOE

confirms the right to use the waters of FOREST CREEK AND HUNTER AND BEST RESERVOIRS NOS. 1 AND 2 CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2370, tributaries to APPLEGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 21.9 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 6.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 26859. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1960. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.355 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under Permit R-2370; provided further that the right to the use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 cubic feet per second at its mouth. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 21, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 474, approving Transfer Application 7776, and together with Certificate 76925, supercedes Certificate 32557, State record of Water Right Certificates.
