CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, tributary to ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 13.65 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13 at Page 70. The date of priority is MAY 1887.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR EACH 50 ACRES OF LAND IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM APRIL 1 TO NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 17, 2006, at Special Order Volume 70, Page 606, approving Transfer Application 9229, and supercedes Certificate 13912, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
