CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, tributary to ROGUE RIVER for DOMESTIC USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 14200. The date of priority is MARCH 12, 1940. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.006 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND AN ANNUAL VOLUME LIMITATION OF 3.6 ACRE-FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at the point of diversion. If the Director notified the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 23, 2010, at Special Order Volume 81, Page 731, approving Transfer Application 10571, and together with Certificate 86498, supersedes Certificate 30441, State record of Water Right Certificates.
