CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PAT AND NAIDA MILLER
8023 SE WOLF CREEK RD
PAULINA OR 97751

confirms the right to use the waters of WOLF CREEK, tributary to BEAVER CREEK for IRRIGATION OF 57.0 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1884.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for stock use, and 72/100 cubic foot per second from July 1st to September 15th of each year for irrigation, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The water user shall operate and maintain the measuring device as required by the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall comply with the requirements necessary to mitigate for injury to instream water right Certificate 75915 as listed below:

- a) A riparian fence, in accordance with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) specifications, will be maintained to exclude livestock from an approximately 1800 foot reach along Wolf Creek for the life of this water right. The water user will employ all reasonable efforts to maintain the fence within ODFW specifications.
- b) Fish passage must be maintained at the diversion structure.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION, REDESCRIPTION OF THE PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 17, 2007, at Special Order Volume 73, Page 469, approving Transfer Application 10253, and supersedes Certificate 618, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
