CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CONNIE S. AND GARY P. VANDEHEY 7075 NW ROY RD CORNELIUS OR 97113

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK DAIRY CREEK, tributary to DAIRY CREEK for IRRIGATION of 13.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-10455. The date of priority is OCTOBER 23, 1931. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the pointx of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of diversion.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERION AND CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 19, 2007, at Special Order Volume 72, Page 380, approving Transfer Application 7326, and supercedes Certificate 12086, State record of Water Right Certificates.
