CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PINE HOLLOW COOPERATIVE, INC. AND DEPARTMENT OF FISH & WILDLIFE  
ROUTE 1, BOX 27  
TYGH VALLEY OR 97063

confirms the right to use the waters of PINE HOLLOW RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-5250, tributary to WHITE RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 16.13 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-33228. The date of priority is JULY 23, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 16.67 ACRE FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

4 S	12 E	WM	10	NE NW	630 FEET SOUTH AND 890 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and further limited to the use of stored water only on lands described as supplemental. Water from the reservoir is to provide a supplemental irrigation supply for lands being benefitted by exchange of water with lands below the reservoir under the terms of an agreement between the Badger Improvement District and Pine Hollow Cooperative, In., and the Pine Hollow Cooperative Water Users agreement. In the exchange, upper lands use water diverted for the lower lands entitled thereto and replace it in a like amount from the reservoir authorized under Permit R-5250.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBUARY 12, 2007, at Special Order Volume 71 Page 157, approving Transfer Application 10228, and together with Certificate 82976, supersedes Certificate 51486, State record of Water Right Certificates.
