CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WADE AND PATRICIA MILLER
13945 NW PHEASANT HILL RD
MCMINNVILLE OR 97128

confirms the right to use the waters of BAKER CREEK, tributary to NORTH YAMHILL RIVER for POND MAINTENANCE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-17622. The date of priority is MARCH 19, 1947.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion. Diversion of water shall not exceed a total annual volume of 19.75 ACRE FEET during the irrigation season, APRIL 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 11, 2007, at Special Order Volume 73, Page 268, approving Transfer Application 9961, and together with Certificate 83436, supercedes Certificate 48212, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
