CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of CORN CREEK, tributary to SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER for INDUSTRIAL/MANUFACTURING USES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-6668. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 20, 1925. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The annual volume limitation under this right is 18.75 acre-feet.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
30 S	3 W	WM	24	SW NW	295 FEET NORTH AND 634 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 24

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

ROAD WATERING WITHIN DOUGLAS COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM, BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT ROAD SYSTEM, AND U.S. FOREST SERVICE ROAD SYSTEM, AND PRIVATE ROADS LOCATED WITHIN DOUGLAS COUNTY, OREGON

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices at each point of diversion. If the Director notified the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other suitable measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 23, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 736, approving Transfer Application 9505, and together with Certificate 86105, supersedes Certificate 7306, State record of Water Right Certificates.
