CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST PRONG LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER, tributary to WALLA WALLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 19.01 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 323. The date of priority is 1902.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.480 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

6 N	35 E	WM	22	NW NE	1290 FEET SOUTH & 1410 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 22

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 7, 2005, at Special Order Volume 64, Page 49, approving Transfer Application 8575, and together with Certificate 81215, supersedes Certificate 1759, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
