confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for MAINTAINING THREE PONDS.

This right was perfected under Permit G-12879. The date of priority is OCTOBER 18, 1994. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.028 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 7, 2004, at Special Order Volume 60, Page 249, approving Transfer Application 9418, and together with Certificate 80667, supersedes Certificate 79171, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
