**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

confirms the right to use the waters of DRY CREEK, tributary to PINE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 30.4 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 7, at Page 148. The date of priority is 1895.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE ACRE FOOT PER ACRE DURING ANY THIRTY DAY PERIOD, NOR THREE ACRE FEET PER ACRE DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON BEGINNING APRIL 1<sup>st</sup> AND ENDING OCTOBER 1<sup>st</sup>, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Acres
6 N	34 E	WM	25	SW SE	12.4
6 N	34 E	WM	25	SE SE	18.0

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as Saunders Ditch.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 23, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 1438, approving Transfer Application 8190, supersedes Certificate 5525, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
