CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MIMI GRAVES
18467 FRYREAR RANCH RD
BEND OR 97701

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the DRY CANYON for IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-12705. The date of priority is AUGUST 31, 1992. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

15 S	11 E	WM	34	SW NW	2131 FEET SOUTH AND 870 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year within April 1 to November 1 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

16 S	11 E	WM	4	SW SW	1390 FEET SOUTH AND 1020 FEET EAST FROM W 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 4

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director originally entered JANUARY 31, 2007, at Special Order Volume 71, Page 115, and a superseding order entered FEBRUARY 28, 2012, at Special Order Volume 87, Page 112, approving Transfer Application 10185, and together with Certificate 83369 and certificates confirming Transfer Applications 10183, 10184, and 10186, supersedes Certificate 82029, State record of Water Right Certificates.
