CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KLAAS DEN HEYER
PO BOX 971
OAKHURST CA 93644

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, tributary to COQUILLE RIVER for COMMERCIAL USE AND HUMAN CONSUMPTION.

This right was perfected under Permit 29235. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 12, 1963. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.006 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for COMMERCIAL USE, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 0.005 cubic foot per second and shall be limited to a diversion not to exceed 1.04 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The amount of water used for HUMAN CONSUMPTION, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 0.001 cubic foot per second and shall be limited to a diversion not to exceed 0.20 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE, POINT OF DIVERSION AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 19, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 1013, approving Transfer Application 7394, and together with Certificate 75739, supersedes Certificate 34441, State record of Water Right Certificates.
