CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RIVER BEND CORP.

confirms the right to use the waters of CHETCO RIVER, tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN for DOMESTIC USE FOR 26 RECREATIONAL VEHICLE SPACES AND A CLUB HOUSE.

This right was perfected under Permit 32724. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 16, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.006 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for domestic use shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.25 acre-feet during the irrigation season of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
40 S	13 W	WM	33	SW NE	400 FEET NORTH & 920 FEET EAST FROM C1/4 CORNER, SECTION 33

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use is as follows:

40 S	13 W	WM	33	SE NW

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 3, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 1181, approving Transfer Application 7052, and together with Certificate 75152, supersedes Certificate 50669, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
