CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BARBARA D. AND MICHAEL G. KNOX

ASHLAND OR 97520

confirms the right to use the waters of LAKE OF THE WOODS, tributary to SELDOM CREEK for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit S-43406. The date of priority is JUNE 5, 1978. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

37 S	5 E	WM	14	SW NW	3510 FEET NORTH AND 350 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 14

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

37 S	5 E	WM	14	SW NW - LOT 2. BLOCK U

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

37 S	5 E	WM	14	SW NW	1420 FEET SOUTH AND 210 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 14

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 3, 2006, at Special Order Volume 70, Page 690, approving Transfer Application 10230, and supersedes Certificate 56031, State record of Water Right Certificates.
