confirms the right to use the waters of WILLIAMS CREEK, tributary to APPLGATE RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 2.6 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1867.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.043 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND DIMINUTION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 12, 2005, at Special Order Volume 66, Page 81, approving Transfer Application 8325, and together with Certificate 81585, supercedes Certificate 49426, State Record of Water Right Certificates.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
