CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE ANDERSON
7795 BERMUDA ROAD
LAS VEGAS NV 89123-1842

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 3.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10670. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 25, 1986. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.


This certificate is issued to CONFIRM AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION, CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 31, 2011, at Special Order Volume 84, Page 350, approving Transfer Application 10927, and together with Certificate 86336, supersedes Certificate 81614, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
