CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BRIAN AND RENELDA BOOTHBY 759 MATHER RD PROSPECT OR 97536

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK ROGUE RIVER and WASTE WATER FROM C.O.P. CO. FLUME, tributaries to ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 3.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-6119. The date of priority is OCTOBER 22, 1923. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 24, 2009, at Special Order Volume 79, Page 223, approving Transfer Application 10681, and together with Certificate 85934, supersedes Certificate 13972, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
