CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TROUT CREEK, tributary to DESCHUTES RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 3.5 ACRES, LIVESTOCK AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jefferson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 57. The date of priority is 1904.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.50 ACRE FEET PER ACRE DURING ANY PERIOD OF 30 DAYS AND 6.0 ACRE FEET PER ACRE DURING IRRIGATION SEASON, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 10, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 996, approving Transfer Application 7701, and supersedes Certificate 2250, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
