CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, tributary to ROGUE RIVER for MINING WATER USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 14, at Page 498. The date of priority is 1883.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, and shall be limited to the irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

Use of the former irrigation pond to hold diverted water under this right is limited to the period April 1 through October 1.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.


The right to the use of the water for mining is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 16, 2005, at Special Order Volume 63, Page 1, approving Transfer Application 9434, and together with Certificate 81135, supersedes Certificate 79479, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
