CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of FOUR MILE LAKE RESERVOIR, within the KLAMATH RIVER BASIN and FISH LAKE RESERVOIR, within the ROGUE RIVER BASIN for MUNICIPAL USE by the CITY OF EAGLE POINT.

The period of use is the irrigation season and the annual volume is limited so as not to exceed 321.3 acre-feet per year.

This right was perfected under permit S-407. The date of priority is MARCH 31, 1910. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.9 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device, for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted, in good working order


Notwithstanding that Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife has made a determination that fish screens and/or by-pass devices are not necessary at this time, the water user may be required in the future to install, maintain, and operate fish screening and/or by-pass devices to prevent fish from entering the diversion, and to provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish.

The maximum quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion, being 0.9 cfs, not to exceed 321.3 acre-feet per year.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION, CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 25, 2006, at Special Order Volume 68, Page 527, approving Transfer Application 9973, and together with Certificate 81635, supersedes Certificate 80573, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).
