 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of COLUMBIA RIVER, tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 6.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-37292. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 7, 1974.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

4 N	25 E	WM	2	NE NW	7	150 FEET SOUTH AND 2990 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 2

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Although this right is supplemental in the interest of conserving groundwater, it may be exercised when groundwater is available provided the quantity diverted from all sources does not exceed the limitation allowed herein. In the event the primary right from the wells is curtailed or abandoned, the land described as supplemental shall be considered as a primary irrigation right.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 22, 2003, at Special Order Volume 58, Page 444, approving Transfer Application 9290, and together with Certificate 80506, supercedes Certificate 75847, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
