CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAVER CREEK, tributary to CROOKED RIVER, for POND MAINTENANCE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-12966. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 23, 1938. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion. The annual volume shall not exceed 44.8 ACRE-FEET, diverted during the irrigation season of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

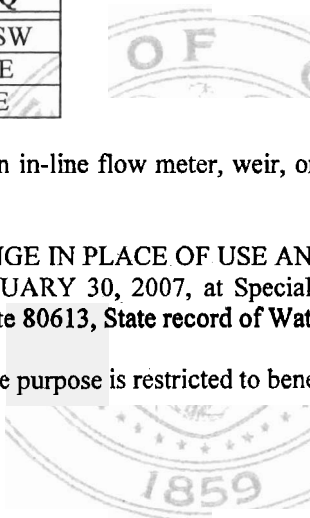
This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 30, 2007, at Special Order Volume 71, Page 106, approving Transfer Application 10180, and supercedes Certificate 80613, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
