## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD STRACHAN 1030 NW JOHNSON #609 PORTLAND, OR 97209

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE UNNAMED SPRINGS, TRIBUTARIES OF KERSHAW CREEK for STORAGE AND MAINTENANCE OF A RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-12068, FOR WILDLIFE HABITAT AND FIRE PROTECTION.

This right was perfected under Permit S-2157. The date of priority is JULY 17, 1914. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The quantity of water stored for wildlife habitat and fire protection shall not exceed 12.0 acre-feet during the irrigation season of each year. The quantity of water stored from October 1 to October 1 of each year shall not exceed 12.0 acre-feet under this water right and the water right perfected under Permit R-12068.
