CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRANKIE PAINTER AND ALBERT TAYLOR
DUFUR, OR 97021

confirms the right to use the waters of Squaw Creek (Whychus Creek), tributary of the Deschutes River for IRRIGATION of 45.72 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record in Salem in the Order Record of the Water Resources Department, in Volume 1, at Page 471. The date of priority is 1908.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for the described purpose and shall not exceed 0.914 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 981, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 09 2013, and recorded in Special Order Volume 89, Pages 1048-1049, canceling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 981.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
