CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 1.4 ACRES AND STOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit S-42288. The date of priority is JUNE 27, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.0205 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.0075 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF 0.6 ACRE, 0.01 CFS FOR IRRIGATION OF 0.8 ACRE, AND 0.003 CFS FOR STOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 28, 2007, at Special Order Volume 73, Page 157, approving Transfer Application 10214, and together with Certificate 83493 supercedes Certificate 55393, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
