CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

METOLIUS LLC  
PO BOX 100  
CAMP SHERMAN OR 97730

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, tributary to METOLIUS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 3.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 6110. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 13, 1923. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.041 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

12 S	9 E	WM	27	SE SW			40 FEET NORTH & 320 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
13 S	9 E	WM	10	SE SW	120 FEET NORTH AND 300 FEET WEST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 10

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and additional point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 18, 2000, at Special Order Volume 54, Page 703, approving Transfer Application 8153, and together with Certificate 76620, supercedes Certificate 5796, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
