CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED STREAM, tributary to COW CREEK for IRRIGATION of 2.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 23185. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 8, 1954. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, NE ¼ NW ¼, SECTION 14, T32S, R5W, WM; 950 FEET SOUTH AND 500 FEET WEST FROM N ¼ CORNER, SECTION 14, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of diversion.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a lockable valve immediately upstream of the meter.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter for measuring and recording the quantity of water in the service line with a valve to regulate the flow through the meter.

The water user shall maintain a staff gage, capable of being rated, at the authorized point of diversion.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an additional point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 19, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 628, approving Transfer Application 7174, and supercedes Certificate 52535, State record of Water Right Certificates.
