CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STEVEN AND ANITA B. HOOPER 223 INDEPENDENCE LANE ROSEBURG OR 97471

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION of .6 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-8700. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 24, 1928. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.007 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion located as follows:

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 8, 2008 at Special Order Volume 75, Page 718, approving Transfer Application 9580, and together with Certificate 84525, supercedes Certificate 83870, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
