CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM A AND BLANCHE PATTERSON
WEST HIGHWAY
JOHN DAY OR 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 3.7 ACRES AND STOCK WATER.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1889.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre IRRIGATED FROM APRIL 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30 (or its equivalent); and IS FURTHER LIMITED TO ONE-ACRE FOOT for each acre irrigated PER CALENDAR MONTH TO JULY 1 AND ¼ ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE THEREAFTER; TOTAL FIVE ACRE-FEET PER ACRE FOR SEASON, MEASURED AT THE POINT OF DIVERSION during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

The new point of diversion shall be regulated with other diversions on the John Day River.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may either petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 31, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 324, approving Transfer Application 6671, and together with Certificate 74220, supercedes Certificate 66805, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above pupose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
