CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, tributary to ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.4 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is MAY, 1887.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.028 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

39 S	8 W	WM	4	NW SW	10 FEET SOUTH & 880 FEET WEST FROM NW CORNER, DLC 37

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

38 S	8 W	WM	27	SE NW	KERBY DITCH – 1600 FEET SOUTH AND 1800 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 27

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0675, you may either petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 21, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 555, approving Transfer Application 8176, and together with Certificate 76110, supercedes Certificate 75116, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
