confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 4.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for MORROW County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The date of priority is 1875.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 3, 2006, at Special Order Volume 70, Page 693, approving Transfer Application 9942, and together with Certificate 82489, supercedes Certificate 53120, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
