The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with the quantity of diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.

- A. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring device; provided however, where the meters or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 22, 2010 at Special Order Volume 81, Page 450, approving Transfer Application 11024, and together with Certificate 86445, supersedes Certificate 82858, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
