CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF SALEM
555 LIBERTY ST SE
SALEM, OR 97301

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, a tributary to the SANTIAM RIVER, for MUNICIPAL USES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Marion County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 14, at Page 354. The date of priority is 1856.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 60.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion, Salem Canal.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Within the corporate limits of the City of Salem, Oregon and surrounding territory.

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 20, 2004, at Special Order Volume 62, Page 327, approving Transfer Application T-7928 and supersedes Certificate 51535, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
