CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SPRING A, SPRING B AND SPRING C, tributaries to BAKER CREEK for COMMERCIAL USE, WATER BOTTLING.

This right was perfected under Permit 41192. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 1, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

4 S	5 W	WM	16	NE NW	50	NORTH 71 DEGREES 17 MINUTES EAST FROM SW CORNER, DLC 50

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion (Springs A, B, C, and D).

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion, and shall be limited to not more than 0.08 cfs, further limited to a diversion not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre transferred (a total of 16.75 acre-feet, per year, described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 17, 2004, at Special Order Volume 60, Page 88, approving Transfer Application 8162, and together with Certificate 80702, supercedes Certificate 56401, State record of Water Right Certificates.
