CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to store the waters of UNNAMED STREAM, tributary to JUMP OFF JOE CREEK for MULTIPLE PURPOSE.

This right was perfected under Permit R-5104. The date of priority is OCTOBER 20, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 4.72 ACRE FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The reservoir is located as follows:



When required by the Department the water user shall install and maintain a suitable device for measuring the quantity of water stored. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 22, 2006, at Special Order Volume 68, Page 89, approving Transfer Application 6826, and supercedes Certificate 39885, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
