confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5104, tributary to JUMPOFF JOE CREEK for RESERVOIR (POND) MAINTENANCE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-33008. The date of priority is OCTOBER 20, 1967.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 29.25 ACRE-FEET during the irrigation season of each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

When required by the Department the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 22, 2006, at Special Order Volume 68, Page 89, approving Transfer Application 6826, and together with Certificate 81638, supercedes Certificate 39886, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
