CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PADRE PROPERTIES, LLC

HUGHSON, CALIFORNIA 95326

confirms the right to use the waters of SUCKER CREEK, tributary to ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 6.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 252 and Volume 3, at Page 396. The date of priority is 1857.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.085 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, and that the use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1st to October 31st of each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:


A description of the place of use is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered, at DECEMBER 1, 1997, Special Order Volume 51, Page 1333, approving Transfer Application 6642, and together with Certificate 75327, supercedes Certificate 38310, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
