CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 1.60 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-22127. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 16, 1953. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

36 S	5 W	WM	24	NW SE	2	430 FEET SOUTH AND 530 FEET EAST FROM C1/4 CORNER, SECTION 24

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of diversion described as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 12, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 451, approving Transfer Application 10851, and together with Certificate 86055, supercedes Certificate 20613, State record of Water Right Certificates.
