CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in APPLGATE RIVER BASIN for PRIMARY IRRIGATION of 4.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8515. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 22, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.056 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 9, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 888, approving Transfer Application 8034, and together with Certificate 75834, supersedes Certificate 64109, State record of Water Right Certificates.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
